Guidelines for On-site Worship Services At CCBC

For the time being, we will return with only worship services-on site. All other on-site ministries, including Sunday school classes, nursery, and other children's ministries will not be provided at this time. There will also not be a fellowship time after the service.

Children are welcome to attend our worship services and sit with their respective households.

Social Distancing

We ask everyone to practice recommended social distancing measures when you arrive here on-site:

- Members of the same household are asked to sit together in the sanctuary.
- Please sit in the designated rows.
- Please maintain a minimum six feet of separation at all times from members of other households.
- After the service you will be dismissed by section to exit the building. Please do not congregate in groups in the atrium, fellowship hall, classrooms, or in the foyer. You may fellowship outside while practicing social distancing.



- If you do not feel comfortable joining with us in worship on-site, or if you may be at a higher risk of developing severe complications due to COVID-19, you are encouraged to continue to join us in worship from home. *Online services will continue indefinitely.*
- If you have symptoms of any sickness, please join us in worship from home.
- Masks or nose and mouth coverings are to be worn by all individuals upon entering the building, during worship services and until you exit the building. Those individuals with a health condition that makes breathing difficult and children under the age of 3 are not required to wear a mask. Please bring your own mask from home. A small number of masks will be made available at the entrance to the parking lot.
- The church facility will be cleaned and disinfected by designated team members before and after the worship service.
- Offering boxes will be placed at the side entrance to the sanctuary and in the back, in lieu of offering plates.
